ABOUT THE BOWL

The ninth edition of the RoofClaim.com Boca Raton Bowl will take place at FAU Stadium on Tuesday, December 20, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. airing live on ESPN.

ESPN Events, along with original league partners Conference USA (C-USA), American Athletic Conference (AAC) and Mid-American Conference (MAC), launched the game in 2014.

The bowl expanded their conference agreements last year, which opened the game to participation from all of the Group of 5 conferences – Sun Belt Conference and Mountain West as well as C-USA, AAC and MAC - plus independents Army and Liberty, alternating each year.

WEEK TEN ACTION

In the AAC... SMU defeated **Houston**, 77-63. This game was the highest scoring non-overtime game in NCAA FBS history. The Mustangs tied the AAC's single-game scoring record with 77 points.

In the C-USA... UTSA held off **UAB**, 44-38, to remain undefeated in C-USA play. The game went into double overtime, which marks the third time this season the Roadrunners have gone into overtime.

In the MAC... Bowling Green stretched its win streak to three after defeating **Western Michigan**, 13-9. The Falcons held the Bronco's to 91 offensive yards in the first half.

In the MWC... San Jose State and **Air Force** became bowl eligible after wins over **Colorado State** and **Army**.

In the SBC... Marshall shut down **ODU**, 12-0, while **South Alabama** defeated **Georgia Southern** as the Jaguar's extended their overall record to 7-2.
