ABOUT THE BOWL

The ninth edition of the RoofClaim.com Boca Raton Bowl will take place at FAU Stadium on Tuesday, December 20, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. airing live on ESPN.

ESPN Events, along with original league partners Conference USA (C-USA), American Athletic Conference (AAC) and Mid-American Conference (MAC), launched the game in 2014.

The bowl expanded their conference agreements last year, which opened the game to participation from all of the Group of 5 conferences – Sun Belt Conference and Mountain West as well as C-USA, AAC and MAC - plus independents Army and Liberty. alternating each year.

In the C-USA... UTSA won its conference opener, 45-30, on the road at Middle Tennessee. The Roadrunners rolled up 590 yards of total offense with quarterback Frank Harris responsible for 414 yards after completing 27-36 passes.

In the MWC... Boise State rallied from a 13-0 deficit to defeat San Diego State, 35-13. The Broncos' freshman guarterback, Taylen Green, had his fist career start and earned MWC Freshman of the Week for his performance.

In the AAC... Cincinnati recorded 11 sacks during its 32-21 win over Tulsa and currently leads the nation with 23 sacks in 2022. The Bearcats have won 15 consecutive AAC reaular-season games, two shy of the league record of 17. **Memphis** defeated **Temple**, 24-13, and are off to a 2-0 start in conference play for the first time since 2016. In the SBC... JMU never trialed in the 40-13 victory over Texas State in


