The 10th annual RoofClaim.com Boca Raton Bowl will be played on Thursday, December 21, at 8 p.m. ET at FAU Stadium on the campus of Florida Atlantic University in Boca Raton. The game will air on ESPN and its selected international networks and on ESPN Radio (locally heard on ESPN 106.3).

Beginning as the Boca Raton Bowl in 2014 and adding current corporate title sponsor RoofClaim.com in 2020, the game has agreements with Conference USA (CUSA), Mid-American Conference (MAC), American Athletic Conference (AAC), Sun Belt Conference (SBC), Mountain West Conference (MWC) and select independents.

Miami (OH) vs. Toldeo



Both the Redhawks and the Rockets hold a first place spot in their conference divisions, making this game a big deciding factor moving forward. The last matchup these teams had was in 2011, resulting in a 49-28 victory for Toledo.

UTSA vs. FAU



found their first conference win in a 45-14 game against **Temple**. Navy brought home a victory after their 14-0 matchup against Charlotte in their second shutout of the season. SMU holds onto an undefeated conference record following their win over East Carolina, while UTSA maintains the same record after defeating UAB. Finally, **Tulane** made it to the AP Poll as #23 following a win against **Memphis**. MAC: Eastern Michigan beat Kent State in a 28-14 game, while Central Michigan defeated Akron 17-10. Both Toledo and Miami (OH) maintained their undefeated conference records after wins over Ball State and Western Michigan. Northern Illinois hosted the **Ohio Bobcats** and managed to defeat them in a 23-13 game. Finally, Bowling Green found their first conference win against Buffalo.

MWC: Fresno State walked away with a 37-32 win against Utah State while SDSU scored 41-34 to win over Hawai'i. UNLV found a 45-27 victory against their in-state rival, Nevada, bringing their conference record to 2-0. SJSU got their first conference win against New Mexico, while Air Force continues their winning streak following a 34-27 defeat over Wyoming. Lastly, Colorado State had a thrilling victory over Boise State after a 33-yard scoring pass with no time left brought the final score to 31-30.

CUSA: UTEP found their first conference win over FIU during Week 7. New Mexico State defeated Sam Houston in a 27-13 scoring game and Liberty maintains their undefeated record following a victory against MTSU in an early Week 8 game. Also in Week 8, Jax. State became bowl eligible after winning 20-17 against WKU.

SBC: South Alabama had a high scoring victory against Southern Mississippi on Tuesday night, with an ending score of 55-3. Troy defeated Army after allowing no points in a 19-0 shutout. Georgia State won over Marshall 41-24, while Texas State defeated UL Monroe 21-20. Finally, JMU continues their undefeated 6-0 record after beating Georgia Southern.
